

Prof. dr RADISAV VIDIC

Radisav D. Vidic is William Kepler Whiteford Professor and Chairman of the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at the Swanson School of Engineering, University of Pittsburgh. His research efforts focus on advancing the application of surface science in environmental engineering, water management for unconventional oil/gas industry, development of novel physical/chemical water treatment technologies, and reuse of impaired waters. He published over 300 journal papers and conference proceedings on these topics that were cited more than 11,000 times in peer-reviewed literature. He was awarded 2008 Professor of the Year by the Pittsburgh section of American Society of Civil Engineers, 2013 University Research Grand Prize for Excellence in Environmental Engineering and Science by the American Academy of Environmental Engineers and Scientists, included in Who's Who in Energy in 2013 and 2014, ranked among World's Top 2% Scientists by Stanford University in 2021. He is registered Professional Engineer, Board Certified Environmental Engineer and Fellow of the American Society of Civil Engineers.
